

### **School Sports Premium: Our Aim**

At St Bede Primary Academy we aim to provide the best PE experience possible for all our children within a very limited space and no green playing areas.

### **Primary School's Sports Funding**

#### **What is the Sports Premium?**

The Government is providing funding of 150 million per annum for academic years 2013/14, 2014/15, 2015/16 and 2016/17 to provide quality primary PE and school sport. Each school will receive £8 000 plus an additional £5 per pupil– for St Bede this will equate to approximately £10,000 per year.

#### **Provision in school**

As a school we already provide high quality Physical Education and sport, and our intention is that this funding will further enhance the existing provision in school.

The Governors agree that the funding must be used so that all children benefit regardless of sporting ability, have the opportunity to compete in competitions at some level and that staff have access to training opportunities and continued professional development.

#### **Our funding in 2016/17 will be used in the following way:**

- To employ a coach to teach sport skills to Key Stage 2 staff and children;
- to continue to employ a dance teacher to promote dance throughout the school;
- to increase competitive opportunities within school;
- to increase provision of Outdoor and Adventurous activities for all of our children;
- to provide training for staff both in-house and off site;
- to offer various after school sporting clubs;
- to supplement funding to provide a more exciting outdoor facility for Years 1-6.

#### **Outcomes:**

- Teaching staff upskilled in the teaching of PE – PE was a focus for lesson observations last year and all achieved a good or better judgement
- Role of dance in the curriculum enhanced and the idea that it is accessible to, and enjoyed by, everyone, irrespective of gender, race etc.
- Resources are more plentiful and stored in a more accessible way
- Climbing wall located in playground
- After school sporting clubs for year groups 1-6
