Dear Parents/Carers,

Critical Worker and Vulnerable Pupil Arrangements – w/c Monday 1st March

As you are aware, we reduced our pupil and staff numbers this week by only offering places to children identified as vulnerable, children whose parents are **both** critical workers and single parents with a critical worker position.

We have now reviewed the current situation, in consultation with our Trust Directors and our Local Governing Body, and can confirm that we can return to offering places to those children who previously had a place, where only one parent is a critical worker. This is for the week commencing Monday 1st March. **Please note that this only applies to children who were previously allocated places and not to children whose names were on the reserve list for critical worker places.**

Following the Prime Minister's announcement on Monday in terms of school re-opening for all children. We are currently reviewing all the updated guidance sent from the DfE, to plan for a safe re-opening on Monday 8th March.

We do ask for your patience; we will communicate to you again as soon as we have finalised this review and discussed our findings and plan of action with our senior management team.
