

Remote Education Information - UPDATED 08.01.2021

While your child is at home, we will continue to offer high quality education remotely. This provision will:

- use the current school curriculum sequence so that knowledge and skills are built incrementally
- deliver a broad and ambitious curriculum each day
- provide access to resources that are linked to the school's curriculum expectations
- be printed, where necessary, for pupils who do not have suitable online access
- allow interaction, assessment and feedback
- personalised to meet the needs of all learners including those with SEND
- match the programme of teaching that pupils would receive in school, including contact with a staff member where necessary

What will remote learning look like for my child?

Remote Learning for Reception children

Phone calls home from a member of school staff (please ensure the school office has an up to date contact number)

For those who **do not** have access to online resources, a printed pack of home learning resources must be collected from the school office. A tweet/class dojo message will be sent when these are ready.

For those who **do** have access to online learning, the following will be provided over Tapestry (please contact your child's key worker for log on details if unsure):

- Resources linked to any challenges set
- Video PowerPoint of phonics session x1 per day
- Video of maths session x3 per week
- Video of literacy session x3 per week
- Video of PE session x1 per week
- Video of RE session x1 per week
- Video of PSED session x1 per week
- Video of cross curricular session x1 per week
- Video of Art/Computing/Music/Mfl x1 video per week

Remote Learning for Year 1 and 2 children

Phone calls home from a member of school staff (please ensure the school office has an up to date contact number)

For those who **do not** have access to online resources, a printed pack of home learning resources must be collected from the school office. A tweet/class dojo message will be sent when these are ready.

For those who **do** have access to online learning, the following will be provided:

1. A daily Live Microsoft Teams call at 9am for a good morning welcome and setting the agenda for the remote learning of the day (Please see Microsoft Teams guide in your child's home learning book)
2. Recorded lesson inputs for 4 lessons a day (Literacy, Numeracy, Phonics, and x1 Foundation Subject) and the resources to support these lessons on the remote learning section of the school website (see the end of this letter for details on how to access this)

SAFE

ACCEPTING

Think carefully before you click on or open something online (e.g. links, adverts, friend requests, photos) as you never know where they may lead to or they may contain viruses. Do not accept something if you are unsure of who the person is or what they've sent you.



R

RELIABLE

You cannot trust everything you see online as some things can be out of date, inaccurate or not entirely true. To find reliable information compare at least three different websites, check in books and talk to someone about what you have found.



T

TELL

Tell a trusted adult if something or someone ever makes you feel upset, worried or confused. This could be if you or someone you know is being bullied online.
